48. Stanzaic Meaning :-

Lord Pärshvanätha, the master of all three worlds, endowed with golden complexion and with a gait like an elephant, destroyer of all four passions and one who has cut apart the Cupid's arrow, may you be ever victorious..... 1

O Lord Pärshvanätha, your graceful body shines with rays emitted by the jewel on the hood of the cobra covering your head and by lightening accompanying the torrential rain; grant me that what I desire.2

This hymn, in praise (chaitya vandana) of Lord Pärshvanätha, is recited while performing sämäyika and Pratikramana.
